## **SALAD TOMATO VARIETIES**

Two varieties of salad tomato, namely *Caracoli* and *Caraïbo* are presently recommended for cultivation in **pure stand**. Both are French varieties and seeds have to be imported.

| Planting distance     | 1.0 x 0.4 m                                | 1.2 x 0.4 m  |
